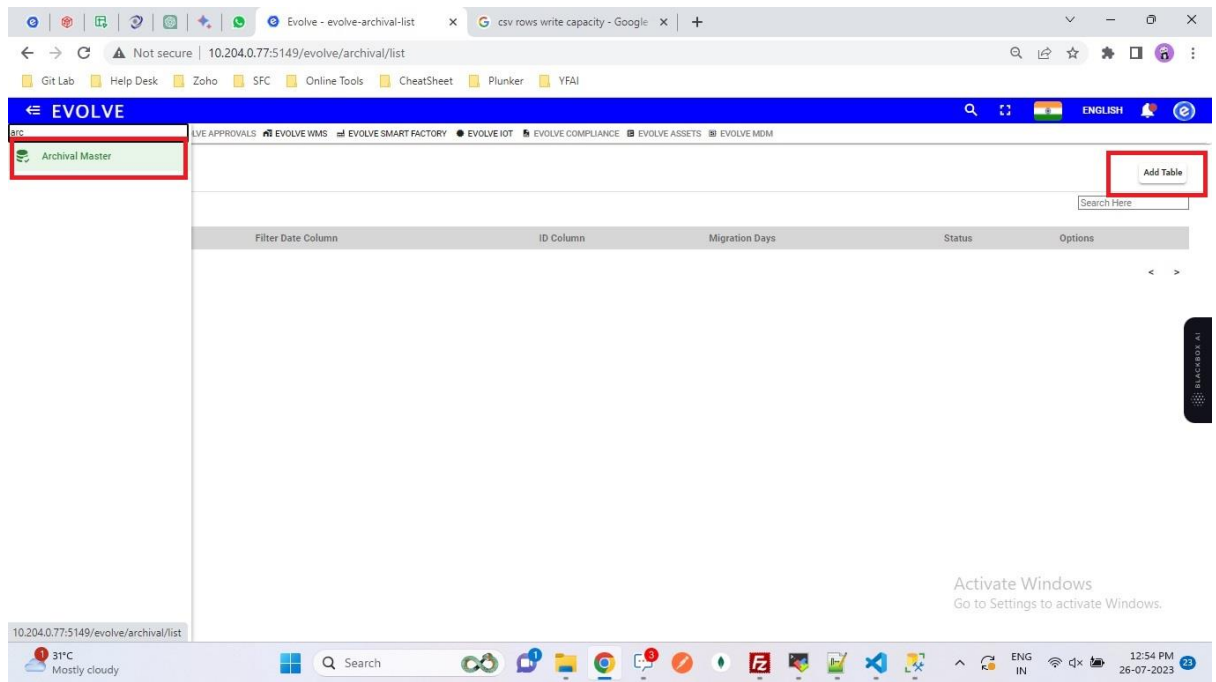


YFAI ARCHIVAL DOCUMENTATION

1. Dynamic Table Archival Configuration

Note: - Do not use this configuration for table **EvolveProdOrders**, **EvolveProdOrdersDetail**, **EvolveProdOrdersDetailChild**

STEP 1: - Open Menu Named “Archival Master” from Dashboard and Press Add New Button.



STEP 2: - Fill the Details

Table Name: - Name of the table you want to archive.

ID Column: - Column Name Of the table which is the Primary ID of the Table.

Filter Date Column: - Column Name of the table which identifies Record Creation date so we can do date range calculation based on days.

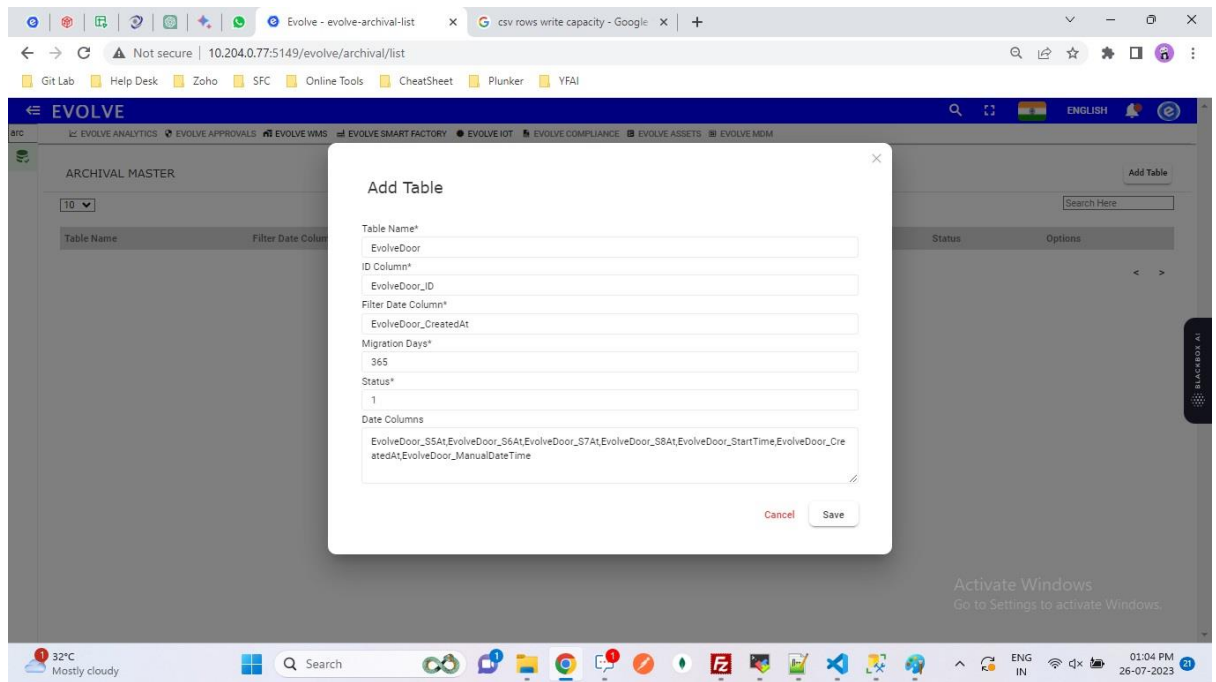
Migration Days: - Records Older than these days will be Archived Every day.

Status: - Status for Enable/Disable for the Table Archive Process.

Date Columns: - In This Field, You have to insert all the column names Coma(',') Separated which has Data Type Date Time.

PRESS THE SAVE BUTTON.

Later You can Modify the records using Edit Button.

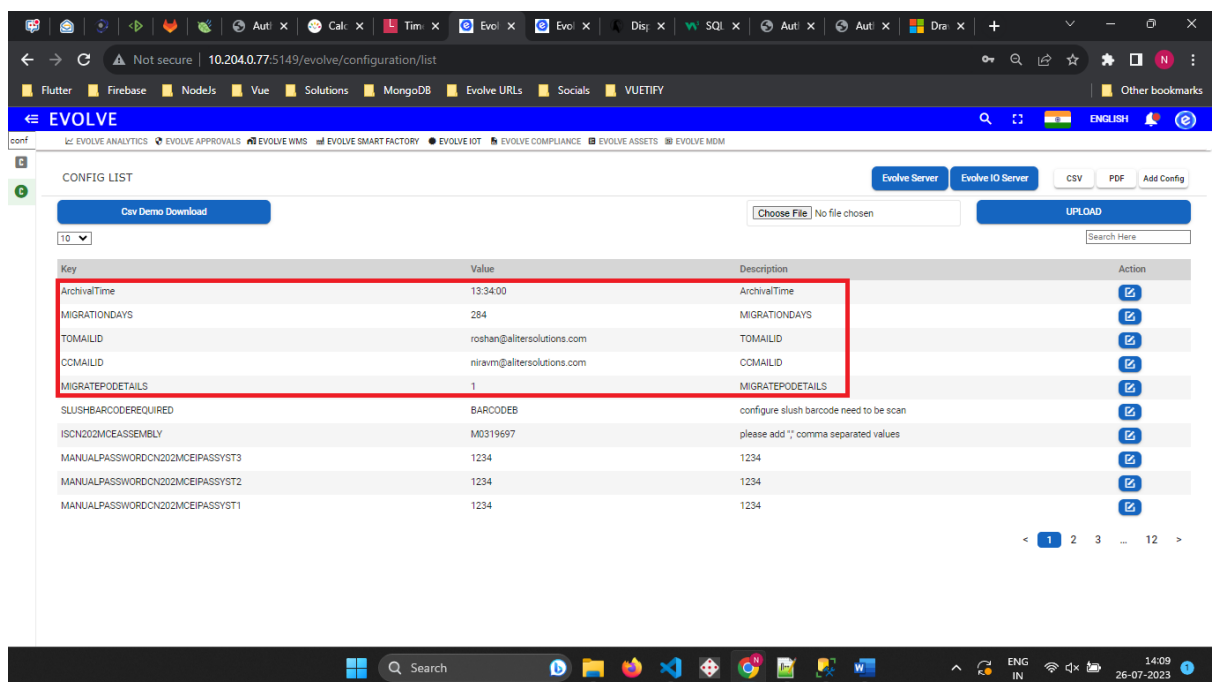


STEP 3: - Open Menu Named "Config" From the dashboard Screen.

CONFIG KEY: - **ArchivalTime** - Time of the day to start Archival Activity. (Same for ProdOrder)

CONFIG KEY: - **TOMAILID** – Mail Id's (Coma (',' Separated for Archival Report) For TO. (Same for ProdOrder).

CONFIG KEY: - **CCMAILID** - Mail Id's (Coma (',' Separated for Archival Report) For CC. (Same for ProdOrder).



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2. EvolveProdOrders Archival Configuration.

Note: - This configuration will Archive Total 3 tables: EvolveProdOrders, EvolveProdOrdersDetail, EvolveProdOrdersDetailChild

STEP 1: - Open Menu Named "Config" From dashboard Screen.

Set **MIGRATEPODETAILS** Key to 1 To Enable PO Archive Process And 0 For Disable.

Set **ArchivalTime** Key in Time Format HH:MM:SS (24 Hours).
