Following are steps for Operational patch installation

- 1) unzip/untar patch file sent
- 2) cp the programs to /dr01/qadapps/qea/patches/mfg/default/src/us/xx (xx is two letter sub directory)
- 3) cd \$QAD_HOME (go to qad install directory)
- 4) run yab update for operational patch using the following command

yab code-mfg-update

NOTE: If you want to have a patch directory following are the steps

- 1) create a directory /dr01/qadapps/qea/patches/mfg/mfgs-xxxx/src/us/xx (mfgs-xxxx is patch name xx is two letter sub directory)
- 2) yab -r (to let yab know about the new directory just created)
- 3) yab code-mfg-update

NOTE: when you are done run following command to verify the configuration of the compile should reflect the name (e.g. mfsg-xxxx) in the propath and sources

yab config "code.mfg.*" grep mfgs-xxxx

NOTE: No compile list is needed. yab tool will recompile all the programs using the include file when an include file is modified by the patch
